Taxi

Taxi fare from Chicago O'Hare Airport is \$33 for one or two passengers, \$14 for each additional passenger. Approximate travel time: 25-30 minutes.

Taxi fare from Chicago Midway Airport is \$33 for one or two passengers, \$14 for each additional passenger. Approximate travel time: 25-30 minutes.

Additional Information

Public Transit and Shuttle Directions:

The hotel recommends either the CTA [public transit] train to downtown or taxi.

From Midway Airport: The train is called the Orange Line train to Downtown and it is located at baggage claim. Just follow the sign that says rapid transit to city. The cost is \$2.25. **TAXI RATES:** \$35 – 40 one way.

From O'Hare Airport: The train is called the Blue Line train to Downtown and it is located at baggage claim. Just follow the sign that says rapid transit to city. The cost is \$5.00. **TAXI RATES:** \$45 – 50 one way.

The Airport Express:

A paid service that is available during normal business hours (7am to 9pm) at both Airports--O'Hare and Midway. The cost is \$30 for the shuttle one way from O'Hare and \$27 from Midway.

Hotel Parking

Overnight valet parking is available at the InterContinental at the rate of \$57+ per night.
