William H. Van Rensselaer Public Service Award

Michael T. Daggett, CPA, of Phoenix, AZ, is NASBA past chair 2011-2012. His involvement with NASBA is extensive. Mr. Daggett is a former chair (2010-2011), vice chair (2009-2010) and director-at-large (1999-2006) of NASBA. He is also a former chair of NASBA's Ethics, Litigation Response and Assistance, Regulatory Structures and Issues, Awards and Nominating Committees. A member and past chair of NASBA's Past Chair Advisory Council, Mr. Daggett served as a member of NASBA's Ethics and Strategic Issues Committee, Global Strategies Committee and Uniform Accountancy Act Committee.

During his term as NASBA Chair, Mr. Daggett was at the helm of NASBA's international efforts and is credited with many of the strides made in promoting NASBA globally, and in bringing the Uniform CPA Examination to international candidates. His program of promoting state boards' activities as a "big deal" resulted in clarity on NASBA's role and position on private company accounting standards, further enhanced NASBA's involvement internationally, and provided continued success in the relevance and effectiveness of state boards and the Accountancy Licensee Database.

Mr. Daggett is a former member of the AICPA's Board of Examiners, Professional Ethics Executive Committee, Quality Review Executive Committee and its Governing Council. He has served as president of the Arizona State Board of Accountancy, as well as the president of the Arizona Society of Certified Public Accountants (ASCPA). As an ASCPA life member, Mr. Daggett was the chairman of the Arizona Tax Liaison Committee and a member of the Society's Arizona Tax Legislation and IRS Tax Liaison Committees.

Mr. Daggett is a retired partner of the firm of Daggett McConachie & Moore, CPAs, LLP. With offices in Phoenix and Sun City, the firm provided accounting and tax services for individuals and small and medium-sized businesses. He was also a partner in this firm's predecessor and has been a partner and held staff positions in other national and local accounting firms, most recently with Michael T. Daggett, CPA, from 2009-2019.

A distinguished past president of the Kiwanis Club of Phoenix, Mr. Daggett holds a Bachelor of Business Administration degree in Accounting from Wichita State University. He and his wife, Sharon Lord Daggett, are the proud parents to two children, Samantha Michele Gort and Anthony Michael Daggett.

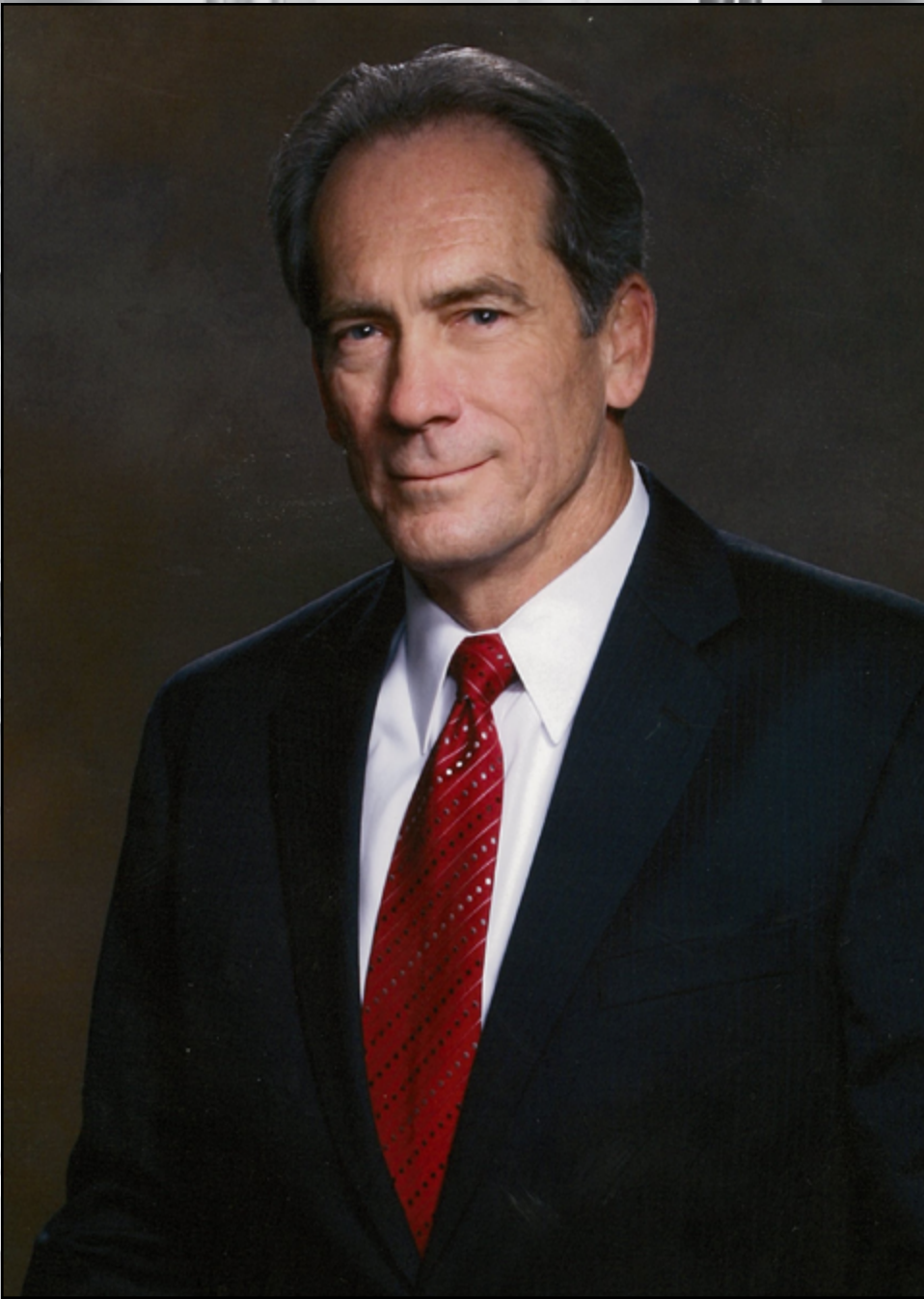

Michael Weinschel, CPA, of Fairfield, CT, served as the Northeast regional director of NASBA, from 2007-2010, and chair of NASBA's Enforcement Assessment and Best Practices Committee, from 2009-2011. Mr. Weinschel is a former co-chair of the Enforcement Manual Task Force and a former member of NASBA's Awards, Enforcement Resources, Ethics, Ethics and Strategic Issues, Nominating, Regulatory Structures and Issues, Regulatory Response, Relations with Member Boards and Uniform Accountancy Act Committees.

A practicing CPA for over 40 years, Mr. Weinschel passed the CPA Examination on his first attempt. His passion was his profession. Most recently, he demonstrated his passion and his high ethical standards as managing member of Weinschel, Wynnicks & Associates, CPAs, LLC.

Mr. Weinschel was appointed to the Connecticut State Board of Accountancy in April of 2002. As a member of the American Society of CPAs (AICPA), he served two terms on Council, chaired the AICPA Joint Trial Board and served on their Accountant's Legal Liability, State Legislation Taxation and State Society Relations Committees. Mr. Weinschel is also a past president of the Connecticut Society of Certified Public Accountants, where he received the Society's Meritorious Service Award and Public Service Award.

His community affiliations included serving as chairman of the Board of United Home Health Care. Subsequently, he served on the Bridgeport Hospital Board and Finance Committee. Mr. Weinschel was very active in scouting and earned the rank of Eagle Scout. He also served as a national representative, scoutmaster, treasurer and vice president of finance and endowments for Boy Scouts. As an acknowledgement of his dedication to the organization, he was honored with a Boy Scouts District Award of Merit.

In 2006, Mr. Weinschel was recognized as one of NASBA's "Remarkable People" because of his charitable work for soldiers stationed abroad, and in 2009, he and his wife, Carol, along with Ms. Susan Spivack, were honored with a NASBA Center for the Public Trust Being a Difference Award, for their continuous encouragement and selfless endeavor to boost the morale of U.S. soldiers overseas through their Soldier Support Packages Initiative, which has adopted over 35,000 deployed soldiers from a variety of Combat Aviation Brigades since 2005.

A native of York, PA, Mr. Weinschel received his B.S. from Marietta College and his M.B.A. from the University of Bridgeport. He and his wife, Carol, are parents to Colonel Matthew and Anne Weinschel and their children, Samuel and Benjamin; Drs.
