Chartered Accountants Ireland

A holder of an Irish Chartered Accountant (ACA/FCA) credential may be eligible to sit for the International Qualification Examination (IQEX) if he or she is a member in good standing with Chartered Accountants Ireland (CAI) and meets the eligibility criteria set forth in the August 21, 2017 Mutual Recognition Agreement (MRA).

This Letter of Good Standing must be completed by CAI and sent by them directly to NASBA. Once completed by CAI, this Letter of Good Standing will be valid for one year from the date it is issued.
